

Asma ul Husna PDF: 99 Names of Allah

Complete List with Arabic, Transliteration, English & Urdu Meaning. Free PDF Guide by Online Tasbih Counter

Asma ul Husna (اسماء الله الحسنى), "the Most Beautiful Names," is the Islamic term for the names and attributes by which Allah describes Himself in the Quran and Sunnah. This guide gives you the full list of the 99 Names of Allah with meanings in English and Urdu, plus how to learn, recite, and reflect on them, drawn from the Quran and authentic hadith.

"And to Allah belong the best names, so invoke Him by them." (Surah Al-A'raf, 7:180)

Are There Only 99 Names of Allah?

The Prophet Muhammad ﷺ said: "*Allah has ninety-nine names, one hundred minus one; whoever preserves them will enter Paradise. He is Witr (One), and He loves what is odd.*" (Sahih al-Bukhari 6410, Sahih Muslim 2677). This 99 is a defined set carrying a specific promised reward, not a cap on Allah's names overall. A du'a recorded in Musnad Ahmad has the Prophet ﷺ asking Allah "by every name You have named Yourself with, revealed in Your Book, taught to any of Your creation, or kept in the knowledge of the unseen," showing Allah has names beyond the enumerated 99.

A Note on the List's Authenticity

The number *ninety-nine* is firmly established in Bukhari and Muslim. The specific enumerated *list* most commonly printed, however, traces to a single narration in Jami' at-Tirmidhi (3507), which Tirmidhi himself graded *gharib* (unusual) and which many hadith scholars regard as a later compilation rather than the Prophet's ﷺ exact wording. Nearly every name on the list below is still independently supported by the Quran or authentic Sunnah. Scholars who have worked on verifying reliable lists include Ibn al-Qayyim, Al-Ghazali, Ibn Hazm, and Al-Qurtubi.

Quick Reference: Which Name Is Commonly Invoked for Which Need

Important: this is not a formula. Reciting a name a set number of times is not a guaranteed cause of a worldly outcome in authentic hadith. Recite with understanding, then make sincere, direct du'a, the name shapes *how* you address Allah, it isn't a spell.

How to use this list: Start with 5-10 names grouped by theme (mercy: Ar-Rahman, Ar-Raheem, Al-Ghafur; power: Al-Aziz, Al-Qadir, Al-Jabbar). Memorize the wording, understand the meaning, then call on Allah by it in du'a, the three steps scholars like Ibn al-Qayyim describe as true *ihsa'* (encompassing the names).
